Just complete this form and enclose your minimum donation of \$125 for each brick. The pathway and the walkway for the bricks are located on the north side of the building bordering West Meeting Street. A permanent plaque has been placed at the site indicating that the Brick Pathway is honoring those who have been a part of our history. The Walkway for The Dignity of Work is in front of the monument honoring our community workforce.

Information for layout of bricks: You are allowed to have 15 characters per line (this includes letters, numbers, slashes periods etc.) Each blank space counts as a character. Three lines are allowed. We will **not automatically** include "**in memory of**" or "**in honor of**"—you must write it in on one of your lines, but we do record any such designations for our records. In a few situations, depending on the shapes of the characters and whether you have the maximum or close to the maximum per line, we may have to abbreviate some or drop a period to preserve the integrity of the brick.
